ARTISTIC DIRECTOR'S PROGRAM NOTES



Welcome to the final concert of the 2020-21 Willamette Master Chorus season. As promised, we are bringing you sacred music from the Mount Angel Abbey. Every three years we visit this sacred place and offer music appropriate to the "church on the hill." This concert, like the previous ones will be virtual. I'm pleased that we could capture some sounds at the church. As you know, I'm very partial to the beautiful organs at the Abbey. Debra Huddleston and Father Teresio will be playing them specifically for this concert.

Our first piece, *Come, Let Us Join Our Cheerful Songs* by Winnagene Hatch, is an American Folk Hymn with words from Issac Watts (1707). This piece highlights the fabulous breadth of sound from the gallery organ in the back of the abbey church.

Laetatus Sum features the altos and sopranos of the chorus singing in Latin to the text of Psalm 122. This original composition by Mother Mary John Sevin features Debra playing the smaller choir organ at the front of the church.

Father Teresio Caldwell plays an organ solo on the gallery instrument. *In dir ist Freude* (In Thee is Gladness) is choral prelude by Johann Sebastian Bach. See if you can pick out this melody that is typically heard at Christmas time. The piece is truly a virtuosic tour de force.

David Schmidt has been writing and arranging for the Willamette Master Chorus for several years. Many of his works have been published and sold throughout the world. I am so pleased that the WMC can premiere this new arrangement of *The Morning Trumpet*. According to David, he wrote this piece as a plea and prayer to bring an end to the challenging and difficult pandemic that we all have faced in 2020.

Rise Up, Ye Saints of God is set to the hymn tune *Festal Song* by William H. Walter. The tenors and basses of the chorus offer a rousing a cappella arrangement by Kenneth Jennings of this 19th century hymn.

The sound of bagpipes with organ is a rare treat. Because of the loudness of the pipes, Debra was able to pull out all of the stops on this old familiar Scottish hymn *Abide With Me*. The miracle of these virtual recordings allowed us to easily balance the sound of the solo voice with the pipes and organ.

I'm not sure there that we will ever hear a jazz band in the abbey church - but there's a first time for everything. *Amazing Grace* is one of the most meaningful and popular spiritual hymns in the United States. Its message certainly resonates with the changing times we are presently experiencing. This arrangement by Whitworth College Professor, Dan Keberle is written in Count Basie swing style for choir and jazz instrumental combo. Don't be afraid to tap your toe!

I'm so pleased that we could bring a miniature version of our season to you through the newly discovered "Virtual Choir." We look forward to returning with the same plan in 2021-22 – same venues, same singers, and same guests, but with new music and renewed commitment to bring our community together with beautiful choral music. We look forward, hoping for full and in-person concerts in 2021-22. We plan on highlighting the same venues, the same singers and guests, but with different music and a renewed commitment to bring our community together with beautiful choral music. Stay tuned and stay safe.


